Though she lived in the shadow of her husband’s fame, she was no shrinking violet, and in many ways, far ahead of her time. She had her own opinions and identity, yet was able to support her husband and family, along with his idiosyncrasies. 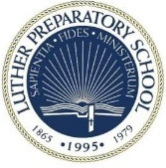

Forgive us our personal sins and the sins of our people.

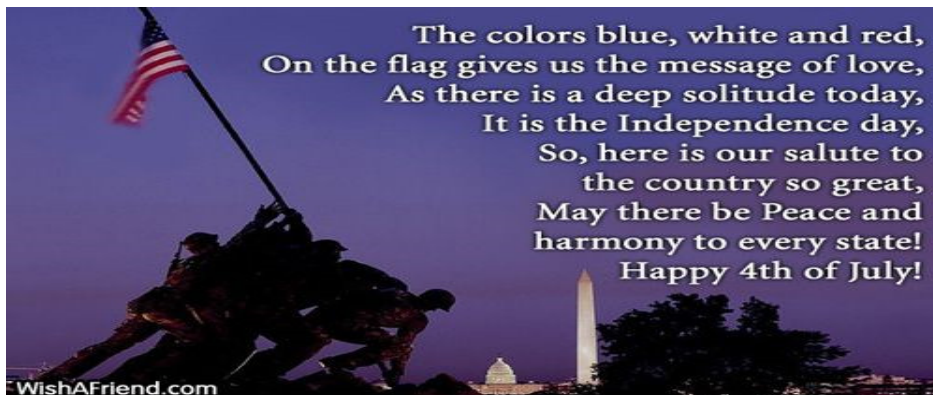
